


#### **Forest Soils Productivity Discussion - 1A**

- Site Class 1-5 (high to low); less than 5 is effectively non-commercial
- Westside soils 50 year site curve basis
- DNR strives for acquiring
   Site Class 1, 2 and 3
- DNR strives to minimize
   Site Class 4 and 5 and
   lower (non-commercial)
   forest acquisitions

Site Class 1	136 and higher
Site Class 2	116-135
Site Class 3	96-115
Site Class 4	76-95
Site Class 5	56-75

## Comparison of Forest Site Classes and their Estimated Yields




Estimate of Net Douglas fir MBF at 50 years of age

#### Forest Soils Productivity Discussion – 1B

- Site Indices get true data from tree height and age (laser rangefinder; increment borer or stump ring count)
- Site Indices get representative data from soil surveys
- Next data step is for volume information
- Specialists in forest mensuration & and biometry





#### Forest Soils Productivity Discussion - 1C


- Volume estimate by age
- Several volume types;
   gross, net, scribner log rule
   16' logs, 32' logs, weight
   tonnage
- Volume, species, sorts, log pricing, costs, help to get to net merchantable value


#### Location

- 14 miles SE of Raymond, WA
- Pacific County
- Private in-holding in DNR's Trap Creek landscape
- Purchase with funds from Legislature





#### **Property**



- 169.93 acres
- 28–30-year-old mixed conifer and hardwoods
- Site Class II-DF, III-WH
- Site Indices; DF-121, WH-104
- Road system over current state trust lands
- Harvest access to the south

#### **Benefits**

- Adds site class 2 and 3 forest land in a good forest area for the trust portfolio
- Removes a private in-holding within DNRmanaged trust lands
- Improves trust revenue potential
- May provide access to existing state trust timber previously inaccessible to the south

#### **Purchase Price:**

- \$500,000, \$2,942/acre
- Encumbered State Forest Land
   Trust funding from the Legislature.
   Part of \$5 million for three SW WA counties.
- Beneficiary to be State Forest Land
   Transfer Trust (01)- Pacific County.
