

State Forest Land Replacement Program 2017–2019 Encumbered Land Transfers

### Purpose

Transfer certain state forestlands, from State Forest Transfer (SFT) trust status, to Natural Resources Conservation Area (NRCA) status, in Counties:

- With a population of 25,000 or less; and
- With risks of timber harvest deferrals greater than 30 years, due to the presence of wildlife species listed as endangered or threatened under the Federal Endangered Species Act.
- Authorized by Laws of 2018, Chapter 298, Section 3059, and RCW 79.22.060.



- Appraised as if unencumbered by endangered or threatened wildlife species under the Federal Endangered Species Act.
- Timber value distributed as if harvested.
  - 75% to the County
  - 25% to the Forestland Development Account
- Land value Park Land Trust Revolving Account to purchase replacement property for the SFT trust.



#### **Benefits**

- Disposes of lands restricted from producing timber revenue for the SFT trust beneficiaries
- Provides immediate funds to support County services
- Provides funds to purchase replacement lands for future County revenues
- Protects habitat for endangered species

#### **Transfer Properties**

- Transfer properties consist of core habitat areas for Northern Spotted Owl and occupied sites for Marbled Murrelet
- Prioritized property list was provided to the legislature
- Appropriations for 17-19 biennium:
  - Pacific County
  - Wahkiakum County
  - Skamania County

- <u>2</u> attended; <u>1</u> testified in favor of the transaction.




