Units 2, 3, 13 (ROW) & 15 (ROW)/Prospector Pit: Turn east onto PA-F-3100, proceed through the gate and drive for 0.2 mi, then turn south onto PA-F-3120 to reach Unit 15 (ROW) and Prospector Pit.
