Driving Directions
Just before mile marker 21 on State Route 542, take a left onto the SU-ML (F1-3 lock) SU-ML is just past Markel road.
Travel 1.7 miles along the SU-ML
Take a left at the split in the road and travel another 2.4 miles on the SU-ML
Continue straight at the intersection of the SU-ML and SU-41 for another 0.5 miles
The SU-4105 takes off to the right (reconstruction)
On the next 0.8 miles of the SU-41, the sale will be on both sides of the road at various points
Turn right onto the SU-4113 0.8 miles past the SU-4105 to access the upper portions of the sale
1.1 miles past the SU-4113, on the SU-41, is the Paradise Pit
