



## Estimated Harvest Levels

### for Marbled Murrelet Alternatives

Tables 1 and 2 show the projected harvest level for trusts based on DNR's 2017 [Draft Financial Analysis](#) and the [Errata Sheet](#), both of which are posted at <http://www.dnr.wa.gov/bnr>. Each level assumes an arrearage harvest of 462 million board feet (MMBF) and thinning an area less than or equal to 1 percent of the acres thinned or harvested in non-riparian areas.
