






State-Owned Aquatic Land



"...all tidelands, shorelands, harbor areas, the beds of navigable waters, and waterways owned by the state and administered by DNR..."




State-Owned Aquatic Land

Leasing: A Strong Emphasis on Stewardship














Information Used in Leasing Decisions

- Permit applications
- Habitat Stewardship Review
- SEPA documents and public comments
- Technical documents and studies
- Detailed site plans
- Information from Tribal consultations
- Aquatic Reserve Management Plans, if applicable





Aquatic Reserve Program

- Created to promote the preservation, restoration, and enhancement of state-owned aquatic lands
- Three types of reserves
- Currently 7 Reserves
