Section 11 Standard Methodology for Conducting Watershed Analysis

The Standard Methodology for Conducting Watershed Analysis, also known as the Watershed Analysis Manual, is a technical publication required by chapter 222-22 WAC. It is used by qualified scientists and experts to determine, at the watershed administrative unit (WAU) scale, conditions of selected public resources and cultural resources. Forest managers then develop site-specific prescriptions that further regulate forest practices to protect public resources and voluntary management strategies to protect cultural resources.
