


## How to Print an Activity Map using the Forest Practices Application Mapping Tool (FPAMT)

This brief tutorial will take you through the steps to print an FPA Activity Map. To begin, note the new URL address for the FPAMT: <https://fortress.wa.gov/dnr/protectiongis/fpamt/index.html#>.



Any bookmarks, shortcuts or links to the old mapping site will no longer work. To ensure a smooth transition to the new mapping tool, please clear your browser's cache and browsing history. Use your browser's Help menu for instructions on clearing the cache and browsing history.

The new mapping tool makes use of pop-up windows. Please disable your browser's pop-up blocker. Instructions for your specific browser are also in the browser's help menu.


The look and feel of the mapping tool has changed, but we hope you find the new layout and functionality intuitive, if not familiar. When you first open the tool, you should see the familiar disclaimer in a pop-up window.



Close the pop-up window by selecting the "Accept" button.

The mapping tool will open to the Activity Map. Enter the township, range and section where your proposed forest practices activity is located.



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Select the Printer icon to print your Activity Map.




The Print Map pop-up window will open. Enter a Map Title for your map.




Then, select the Print button.

The Print Map message changes while the map is constructed.



When the map is constructed, a .pdf image of the map is displayed. Use your operating system's Print function to print a copy of the map. Use your operating system's Save As function to save a copy of the map.




## Other Useful Functions


Use the Identity tool to view data associated with a layer.




Select the Active tab. Then highlight the active layer.



Select an area or point on the map.



A pop-up window opens displaying the data. Use the arrows to move between records.



Use the Map Themes drop-down to select other maps.
