CMER Updates:

A.J. Kroll, CMER co-chair, reviewed the CMER SAG Updates document and what was discussed at last month's CMER meeting.

Brandon Austin told the story of how he started with the Department of Ecology and Ecology's part of TFW Policy.

Open Public Meeting Act (OPMA) Video:

Lori Clark explained that the video shared was created by the Attorney General's office and is a requirement for CMER members to watch. The video was shared on the screen and Lori answered questions after the video.

Co-chair Nomination:

Court Stanley explained that it is time to accept co-chair nomination and will have a vote at the August 2023 TFW Policy Meeting.

Tom O'Brien nominated Court Stanley; Court did not accept the nomination.

Darin Cramer nominated Cody Thomas; Cody accepted his nomination.

Anadromous Fish Floor (AFF) Proposal Initiation:

Lori Clark introduced the Anadromous Fish Floor (AFF) Validation Study Proposal Initiation (PI) and Adaptive Management Program Administrator (AMPA) assessment. The assessment recommendation is to assign this proposal to a science track and for CMER to prepare technical summary for TFW Policy consideration that clarifies how the AFF validation study would best fit as a companion or add-on study to the existing Potential Habitat Breaks (PHB) study, including the recommended timeline for scoping and implementation to inform effective and efficient sequencing. Careful consideration must be given to integrating this validation study into the Water Typing Strategy suite of projects given the status, cost, and timing of the current PHB study. Additionally, AMP staff and CMER participant capacity limitations will limit the pace of the AFF Validation Study.

Master Project Schedule:

At the Policy budget workgroup requested that Lori bring forward the MPS with a negative balance and a balanced MPS for Policy consideration and for sharing with the FPB to demonstrate the consequences of the contingency plan. Lori recommended that Policy approve the MPS budget with a negative variance with the assurance that the Policy budget workgroup will continue to monitor the FY24 balance to carry over to FY25 and make adjustments as needed. OFM balance data comes up every 6 months. Lori will work with the Policy budget workgroup to monitor the balance. Cody suggested that Policy could look at shifting the phasing of projects as opposed to applying the 20% decrease to projects in FY25.

TFW Policy Operating Procedures:

Greer Maier from Triangle Associates gave a brief introduction to the TFW Policy Operating Procedures document. Rico suggested that we need to check for the statutory/regulatory consistency. It was decided that TFW Policy members will review the document and have all comments/edits completed by the end of business on July 27th. Policy will discuss the comments/edits at the August 2023 TFW Policy meeting and have it as a decision item on the September 2023 TFW Policy agenda.

Bias Exercise:

Lori Clark explained that this exercise is a continuation from the Interest-Based Negotiations workshop on May 3, 2023, that Triangle Associates had put together. She then explained the instructions for the exercise for the breakout rooms. TFW Policy members went into the breakout rooms and did the exercise. After there was discussion on thoughts about the exercise and discussed anything that was surprising.
