Warren Seyler from the Spokane Tribes gave a presentation about the history of the Spokane Tribe.

Riparian Characteristics and Shade (RCS) Update

Rachel Rubin gave a presentation giving an update on the Riparian Characteristics and Shade (RCS) project and answered questions.

Voting Abstain vs. Sideways

At the September meeting there was discussion on whether to use abstain vs. Sideways, and this month to make a decision. Lori Clark explained that either can be used, but there needs to be consistency and there should be a reason listed for your reasoning for voting that way.

CMER Reform

CMER reform was noted as one area of improvement for the AMP in the SAO report. The CMER reform options memo came from one-on-one meetings with Policy members. Policy discussed the 3 options at the September meeting, and this is a decision item. The recommendation will be provided to the Forest Practices Board at their November meeting. After some discussion it was decided that the SAO workgroup will need to have further discussions on this topic.

Schedule L-1 Review and Revision Process Recommendation Memo

The Schedule L-1 process memo was presented to Policy earlier this month. The joint CMER/Policy workgroup made changes based on CMER/Policy input. CMER approved the Schedule L-1 Process memo and with Policy's approval this will move as a recommendation to the Forest Practices Board at the November meeting.

TFW Policy Manual

Triangle Associates drafted the TFW Policy Manual in March of this year. We have gone through several review periods. The goal for today was to review the edits and discuss some of the comments that need consideration and have Policy approval so that the Manual would be available at the November Board meeting along with the BM22 language that references the Policy Manual. However, Lori received additional comments from two Policy members late last week thus she does not think that Policy will be in a position for a decision today. Tracy Hawkins shared the draft BM22 edits with Policy.
