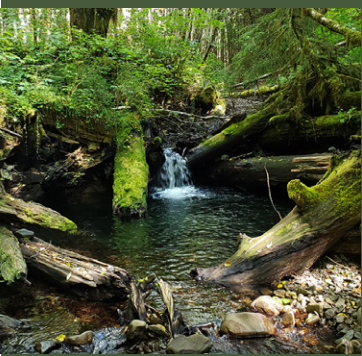
Join the Washington Department of Natural Resources for the 7th annual update on scientific research and monitoring in the Olympic Experimental State Forest (OESF).
