2) THIS FIREWOOD PERMIT MUST BE PROPERLY COMPLETED, SIGNED, AND DISPLAYED IN THE WINDSHIELD OF YOUR VEHICLE WHEN CUTTING AND HAULING FIREWOOD FROM STATE LAND.
3) TO REPORT A FOREST FIRE CALL 1-800-562-6010. To report firewood theft, or cutting outside of a permit area, please call the South Puget Sound Region Office at 360-825-1631.
4) The Permittee agrees to hold DNR, and its agents, harmless for any and all damages to persons and/or property that may occur as a result of using this permit.
5) VIOLATION OF THE TERMS AND CONDITIONS LISTED HEREIN MAY RESULT IN PERMIT FORFEITURE AND/OR CITATION.

CLOSED SEASON
(April 15 thru October 15)
6) THE FOLLOWING CONDITIONS SHALL APPLY TO FIREWOOD GATHERING WITHIN THE CLOSED SEASON:
a. The closed season shall occur annually between April 15 and October 15 unless modified by DNR.
b. The IFPL Shutdown Zone for this firewood unit is 651 N
c. Power saw use is allowed only on days designated as a PRECAUTION LEVEL 1. Please call 1-800-527-3305 or visit https://fortress.wa.gov/dnr/protection/ifpl/ to check the daily precaution level.
d. A shovel must be on site at all times.
e. A $2 \frac{1}{2}$ pound (or greater) fire extinguisher must be on-site at all times.
f. All power saws must have an approved spark arrester.
g. A one hour fire watch is required following the completion of all power saw use.

## PERMIT CONDITIONS

A. THIS PERMIT AUTHORIZES THE REMOVAL OF FIREWOOD FROM SPECIFIED DNR LANDS SUBJECT TO THE TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF THIS PERMIT.
B. FIREWOOD MAY ONLY BE REMOVED FROM THE APPROVED UNIT(S) AS SHOWN ON THE ATTACHED MAP(S).
C. ALL FIREWOOD MUST BE DOWN AND DEAD; REMOVAL OF STANDING TIMBER IS PROHIBITED.
D. ALL FIREWOOD MUST BE LOCATED WITHIN_100_FEET OF AN ACTIVE ROAD OR LANDING.
E. FIREWOOD CUTTING IS PROHIBITED WITHIN RIPARIAN MANAGEMENT ZONES.
F. FIREWOOD CUTTING IS PROHIBITED WITHIN LEAVE TREE CLUMPS AND OTHER AREAS AS POSTED. TREES MARKED WITH PAINT SHALL BE LEFT IN PLACE AND MAY NOT BE CUT OR MOVED.
G. All vehicles must stay on existing roads and/or landings.
H. Vehicle use is prohibited in areas that have been abandoned or closed.
I. Use of ATV's, ORV's, and/or motorized equipment (excluding power saws), is prohibited within the firewood unit.
J. Mechanical yarding is prohibited on DNR land.
K. The firewood unit may be closed, suspended, or terminated at any time as deemed necessary by DNR.
L. Firewood is available on a first come, first serve basis only; DNR cannot guarantee the quantity/quality of firewood available.
M. Firewood is intended for personal use only; the permit and/or firewood may not be traded or sold.

N . This permit is valid for one household only and is non-transferable; each household may remove a maximum of six (6) cords of wood each calendar year from DNR land (RCW 79.15.420) regardless of how many permits are obtained.
O. This permit is valid only for the person and vehicle listed on the permit.
P. Smoking in logged areas is illegal and may cause a serious fire.
Q. THIS FIREWOOD UNIT CLOSES ON April 15, 2024 . No firewood shall be removed after this date.
R. Firewood units will be open seven (7) days a week unless otherwise posted.
S. Firewood units will be "open" daily from DAWN to DUSK unless otherwise posed. During the "closed" period, access to the firewood unit may be restricted through the use of gates and locks.
T. Cutting live trees or standing snags is NOT permitted.
U. NO CEDAR MAY BE CUT OR REMOVED FROM DNR LAND.
V. All ditches, roads \& landings must be left clean and free of firewood debris.
W. Caution shall be taken to minimize damage to newly planted seedlings and standing timber.
X. Do not block roads to other vehicle, logging trucks, or pedestrian traffic
Y. Do not open up blocked roads or skid trails.
