Permit Valid: Oct. 16, 2020 – Nov. 30, 2020
Whiskey Throttle Timber Sale

A Discover Pass is required to access DNR recreation lands. For information on how to purchase the pass, visit www.discoverpass.wa.gov or call 1-866-320-9933. Find out where you'll need a Discover Pass on DNR-managed state trust lands at www.dnr.wa.gov/recreation.

Permit must be in vehicle window and available upon request

Do not cut any standing trees, snags, or blow-down timber.

Only cut within the boundaries of the recently harvested areas, and only within 200 feet from truck roads. No cutting is allowed in wooded areas along roadways.

**Firewood is for personal use only
Do Not Block Roads**

- 1) Limit of 6 cords per family with this permit.
- 2) Cut only wood that is dead and on the ground.
- 3) Cedar is not authorized for removal.
- 4) Firewood cutting will be allowed during the closed season if the following conditions are met:
 - o No cutting is allowed on fire precaution level 2 or above. Call 1-800-323-2876 for this information.
 - o All fire tool requirements must be met for power saws, including approved spark arresters, fire extinguishers, and shovel.
 - o Smoking is not allowed in unit on a level 2 or above day, except in vehicles.

Obey all signs posted in the unit

- 5) Do not disturb ANY planted seedlings if present.
- 6) Motorized equipment and/or vehicles must stay on roads (do not drive on skid trails).
- 7) **No removal or cutting of firewood is allowed more than 200 feet from truck roads.**
- 8) **Do not cut firewood on the road. Keep road surface and ditches clean.**
- 9) **Roads on attached maps may be abandoned at any time.**

Any false statement made in this application or violation of these terms is punishable as a Gross Misdemeanor.

RCW 79.15.440

This permit may be voided by any State DNR Forester on demand.

The firewood area will be closed if abuse or permit violations occur, and permits will no longer be valid. Please report any violations to DNR Northwest Region, 360-856-3500; Report Fires 1-800-562-6010.







<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Timber Sale Unit Haul Route Highway Milepost Markers Rock Pit Bridge Distance Indicator Gate (F1-3) 	<p>From the North: Drive south on Highway 9 from Sedro Woolley, turn left onto Walker Valley Rd (9.8 miles south of Sedro Woolley). Drive 2.2 miles and take a right onto Peter Burns Rd. Drive 2.0 miles to reach WV-08 spur. Walk WV-08 spur to reach Units 2 & 3. On WV-ML drive 0.4 miles to Unit 1. Take a right onto WV-13 road and drive 0.8 miles to Unit 4.</p> <p>From the south: Heading south on Highway 9 from Sedro Woolley, turn left onto Lake Cavanaugh Rd (11.5 miles south of Sedro Woolley). Drive 4 miles along Lake Cavanaugh Road before turning left onto Peter Burns Rd. Peter Burns road becomes Walker Valley Maintline (WV-ML) after 0.35 miles. Continue along WV-ML 2.2 miles to Unit 1. Drive 0.4 miles and turn left onto WV-13 road. Go through the gate and drive 0.8 miles to Unit 4. On WV-ML, drive 0.4 miles north from Unit 1 to reach WV-08 spur. Walk WV-08 spur to reach Units 2 & 3.</p>
