PURCHASER'S CORNER

****NEW TOOL FOR PURCHASER'S****

The Department of Natural Resources (DNR) has designed a Query tool to assist prospective Purchaser's in identifying DNR timber sales that meet their needs. The timeframe for the Query is the current month plus the next two months. For example, February, March and April. The tool allows the user to look at sale specifics such as: Region the sale or sales are in, species, average DBH range, rings per inch, percentage of a species in the sale and percentage of grade.

The Query uses dropdown menus to make choices. Instructions are available by clicking on the "user documentation" in the bottom left on the query page or clicking the "Query Instructions" link on the query page which is located at:

Instructions for completing purchase log sort sale - sealed bid form.

All bids submitted for the purchase of forest products being sold by the Washington State Department of Natural Resources must have an original signature on behalf of the person or entity submitting the bid, and must be on the form provided in this booklet or a photocopy thereof. The DNR will not accept bids that are not signed, and will not accept bids that are not on the current, approved bid form. All appropriate blanks (Agreement Number, Sort Number, Preferred/acceptable log lengths, Bid amount (per mbf or per ton as appropriate for the sort being bid), Bid deposit amount, Signatures and date) on bid form must be completed including the bid bond number if bidder is relying upon a bid bond for bid deposit.

For more specific information, contact the appropriate region office.

In-Person Bids

- A. Sealed bids must be in auction box or auction envelope before 10:00 a.m. on the day of sale at the location specified in the notice of sale.
- B. Sealed bids must be submitted in an envelope with the name of the sale, the bidder's name and the contract agreement number clearly written on the outside of the envelope. The full legal name and business address of the bidder must be inserted where indicated on the form, and must be the same as the name on the bid bond and timber sale contract. The bid form must be signed by an authorized person. When a bidder has more than one person authorized to bid, then documentation of those persons with signature authority for bidding must accompany the bid or be on file at the region office. Sealed bid envelopes are available at all region offices. One bid per envelope, please.
- C. Sealed bid envelopes must contain the following:
 - 1. A completed bid form; and
 - 2. A bid deposit.

Mailed Bids

- A. Mail-in bid envelopes are required to have printed on the outside: "DO NOT OPEN UNTIL SALE DATE. SEALED BID ENCLOSED." The sealed bid envelope(s) will be enclosed inside the mailed-in envelope. Mailed bids must be submitted in an envelope with the name of the sale, the bidder's name and the agreement number clearly written on the outside of the envelope. The full legal name and business address of the bidder must be inserted where indicated on the form, and must be the same on the bid bond and timber sale contract. The bid form must be signed by an authorized person. When a bidder has more than one person authorized to bid, then documentation of those persons with signature authority for bidding must accompany the bid or be on file at the region office. Mail-in envelopes are available at all region offices. One bid per mailed-in envelope, please.
- B. Mail-in or otherwise delivered bids will be accepted up to 4:30 p.m. the last business day before the auction by the region office in which the sale is located. Bidders assume the risk for the method of delivery they chose. The DNR assumes no responsibility for any delays caused by any delivery service.
- C. Sealed bid envelopes must contain the following:
 - 1. A completed bid form; and
 - 2. A bid deposit.

HARVEST METHOD: Highlead and Shovel. A motorized carriage will be required for portions of Units 3 and 4. Shovel yarding will not be permitted from November 1 to April 30 unless authorized in writing by the Contract Administrator.

ROADS: 108.97 stations of required construction. 85.62 stations of required reconstruction. 70.04 stations of optional construction. 17.00 stations of optional reconstruction. There are 310.2 stations of required pre-haul maintenance and 62.58 stations of optional pre-haul maintenance. Unit #3 was cruised using a variable plot sample with a BAF of 54.45 and 62.5 on a 350 x 350 foot grid. The right of way was cruised using a variable plot sample of 40.00 and 33.61 on a grid averaging every 770 feet apart.

FEES: Purchaser must pay Bloedel Timberlands Development Inc., \$60,000.00 on the day of sale for timber and right of way timber. \$98,820.00 is due on day of sale. \$13.25 per MBF is due upon removal. These are in addition to the bid price.

SPECIAL REMARKS: Units #2 and #3 contain some blowdown. Sale is located behind a locked gate. Contact the Olympic Region's Dispatch Center at 360-374-6131, to obtain a AA-1 key.








See Road Plan for Pre-Haul



ACREAGE DETERMINATION

CRUISE METHOD: Acreage was determined by traversing boundaries using a laser and hand compass. All units were cruised using a variable plot sample with a BAF of 54.45 on a 330x165 foot grid.


