Be Campfire Safe, Prevent Wildfires

RECREATIONAL FIRES ARE NOT ALLOWED ON STATE LANDS EXCEPT IN APPROVED DESIGNATED CAMPGROUNDS

- Find out fire restrictions where you will camp.
- Keep a shovel and water close at hand when your campfire is going.
- Use water to drown the campfire and use a shovel to stir the water and coals to cool it down. Repeat as needed.
- The fire must be attended at all times by a person capable of extinguishing it quickly.
- Completely extinguish the fire before you leave.

COMPLETELY EXTINGUISH THE FIRE BEFORE YOU LEAVE Keep the fire small. A small fire surrounded by rocks gives plenty of heat. OK TO LEAVE OK TO LEAVE 10 FT. OR MORE
